# FRANCE AND LEBANON: PARTNERS FOR PEACE AND STABILITY

# Strong and regular diplomatic relations

- Since 2015: 12 visits to Lebanon by French Ministers and Presidents
- August 2017: visit to France by Lebanese Prime Minister Saad Hariri
- September 2017: State visit to France by Lebanese President Michel Aoun

## **Close human and cultural ties**

- > half of Lebanese pupils receive bilingual education in French
- > 5,000 Lebanese students in France, their top destination
- 40 schools with French curriculums, including 6 French lycées
- 9 Institut Français branches

#### **Intense economic and trade relations**

- Considerable **reciprocal investment**:
  - stock of French direct investment in Lebanon: €598 million (end of 2016)
  - stock of Lebanese direct investment in France: €3.93 billion (end of 2016)
- > 4,700 French businesses export to Lebanon
- > 100 French businesses established in Lebanon

## Concrete commitment to Lebanon's stability and unity

- About **700 French soldiers** within the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL)
- Strong support for Lebanese institutions and armed forces
- Since 1999, signature of 27 financing agreements by the Agence Française de Développement (AFD) worth a total of almost €1.2 billion

# In response to the Syrian crisis, France is mobilized in support of Lebanon

• Lebanon is the leading beneficiary of **French humanitarian and stabilization aid** in the region: €115 million since 2012 and a commitment of €100 million over the period 2016-2018
