Overview as on 11 December:

## In Guinea

Establishment of 4 Ebola treatment centres in the forest region of Guinea

- Run by the Red Cross with the support of Médecins Sans Frontières
- Financing and support staff from the French government

#### Establishment of 3 healthcare worker training and treatment centres

Supporting the creation of the future Institut Pasteur medical centre in Conakry

- Diagnosis and surveillance of haemorrhagic fevers
- Training of Guinean biologists in collaboration with the Instituts Pasteur in Dakar and Paris

Sending public health experts to the Guinean authorities

Providing medical and personal protective equipment to Guinea Helping establish 4 laboratories in Guinea

Strengthening primary health care services in the forest region of Guinea Ensuring airport health controls on arrival and departure (France, Guinea, Mali)

## In regional countries

Financing prevention plans against the epidemic in neighbouring countries, in particular Côte d'Ivoire, Mali, Cameroon and Liberia

Medical research and researcher training in 7 West African countries
