



On the theme:

"TO BE BORN SOMEWHERE...

« Billions of people over the planet, in cities, villages, in the heat or cold, at seaside, in mountains or in the country. Each of us, particle of dust on the globe "was born somewhere", in his family, has grown up there, has made friends...

I don't know you, I don't know where you have been living. Let me guess this place through a drawing, a painting, as you see it and as you feel it.

Little by little you left the family to get opened to the so vast world. This experience made you feel conscious that your place of childhood has been engraved in your memory: a place, an event, a meeting... One of these is coming spontaneously to your mind. It will be the start of your creation in which your imagination is going to transform this memory. »



Rules of competition

- Competition is open to young people from 3 to 25 years old, following 6 age groups:
 - 3 to 5 years old, 6 to 9 years old, 10 to 13 years old, 14 to 17 years old and handicapped children.
 - Finally, to young artists from 18 to 25 years old who must join the commentary of their artistic creation, in French or in English.
- 2 Individual or collective participations are accepted.
- 3 Only forms of creations on flat surface, such as drawing, pastel, painting, photography, engraving, are accepted. We don't accept sculptures anymore.
- 4 Maximum sizes accepted: 1.20 x 0.90 metres.
- Only one project per participant.
- 6 Deadline for sending competitive works: on February 28th, 2013.
- 7 Fill up the enclosed label in block letters and stick it at the back of work.
- 8 Works will be conveyed to Troyes under the competitor's responsability who will have to pay the transport fees.
- 9 Jury's meeting on March 23th. 400 nominated works will be selected, of which 100 will be declared laureate. The nominated will receive a diploma and will appear on our web site.
- The jury is composed of professionals in visual arts and of personalities with an intercultural vision.

- Prize-giving ceremony will be on Saturday June 1st 2013 during the International Art Convention "GRAINES D'ARTISTES DU MONDE ENTIER" which will take place in Troyes (France) between the 28th and the 1st of june.
- Prize-winning list will be available on our website: http://centre-unesco-troyes.com from April 12th, 2013.
- In each category (except 18-25), the 1st prize, 2nd prize and 3rd prize will be awarded a cheque of respectively 100€, 85€ and 70€. The other laureates will be awarded professional visual arts material and will receive a honour diploma.
- In the category young artists 18-25, the 1st prize, the 2nd prize and the 3rd prize will get respectively 300€, 200€ and 150€. The other laureates will get professional visual arts material and will get a honour diploma.
- The global endowment of the competiton will be 6000€.
- All the works received, prize-winning or not, remain the property of the UNESCO Centre Louis François which may use them for whatever purpose within its own activities.
