

4th Ministerial Conference on Feminist Foreign Policy Frequently Asked Questions

- **Where will the conference be held?**

The 4th Ministerial Conference on Feminist Foreign Policy will take place at the Ministerial Conference Center, located at 27 rue de la Convention in Paris. Some official events may also be held at the Hôtel du Ministre, 37 Quai d'Orsay.

- **What will be the format of the conference?**

The conference will last a day and a half, from Wednesday, October 22 (2 p.m.) to Thursday, October 23 in the evening. In a multi-stakeholder format, the event will combine high-level plenary sessions and smaller round tables. As the capacity of the plenary room is limited, listening rooms will be available to follow the exchanges.

- **Will interpretation be provided during the conference?**

In the plenary hall, discussions will be interpreted into French, English, Spanish, and international sign language. During the round tables, discussions will be interpreted into French, English, and Spanish.

- **Will the sessions be broadcast?**

The plenary sessions will be broadcast live. The broadcast link will be shared on the website.

- **Will the conference be covered by the media?**

The press and media will cover the plenary sessions of the conference. The round tables will not be recorded or broadcast, in order to ensure the fluidity and freedom of discussion.

- **Will accommodation and meals be provided?**

A buffet lunch will be provided at the Ministerial Conference Center for all participants on Thursday, October 23rd.

The Conference will be held in the 15th arrondissement of Paris, where you will find many hotels. Unfortunately, the Ministry is unable to recommend a particular hotel.

- **Is it possible to organize a side event during the conference?**

Side events will be organized in Paris during the Conference. October 21st and the morning of October 22nd are ideal times to organize these events, in order to ensure their visibility in line with the official program.
