Her Majesty the Queen of
the United Kingdom of Great
Britain and Ireland being
extremely desirous that the
export of Slaves from the
jurisdiction of her Highness
the Sultan of Muscat should
cease, and by this her Highness the
Sultan of Muscat, in reference
to the wishes of Her Majesty
and of the British Nation, and
in furtherance of the dictates
of humanity, which have
heretofore induced him to enter
into

into engagements with
Great Britain to restrict
the export of Slaves from
his Dominion, being willing
to put an end to that trade,
and after notifying the Queen
of the United Kingdom of
Great Britain (and Ireland)
and His Highness the Sultan
of Muscat having resolved
to record with due form
and solemnity, this ~~fourth~~
supplication of the export of
Slaves, and after Majesty
having given due authority
to Captain Lancaster, his
representative at the Court of
the Sultan of Muscat, to
conclude an Agreement with
His Highness accordingly;
his Highness Jassid Saïd Ben
Sultan, for himself, his heirs
successors, and Captain Hamerton
on behalf of the Queen of the
United Kingdom of Great
Britain and Ireland, her being
and successors, have agreed
upon and concluded the following
Articles

Art. 1 His Highness the Sultan of
Muscat hereby engages to prohibit
under the severest penalty, the
export of Slaves from his African
dominions, and to issue orders
to his officers to prevent and
suppress such trade.

II. His Highness the Sultan of
Muscat further engages to prohibit
under the severest penalty, the
importation of Slaves from any
part of Africa into his ports
any in Asia, and to use
his utmost influence with all
the chiefs of Arabia, the Red
Sea, and the Persian Gulf,
in like manner to prevent
the introduction of slaves from
Africa into their respective territories.

III. His Highness the Sultan of
Muscat grants to the ships
of Her Majesty's Navy, as well
as to those of the East India
Company, permission to seize
and confiscate any vessels the
property of His Highness or
of his subjects carrying on
Slave Trade, excepting only
such

such as we engaged in the
to our south of slaves from one
part to another of his own
dominions in Africa, between
the part of slaves to the North
and its dependency, the northern
limit of which is the North
point of Newbroo Island,
in 105° 1' south latitude, and
the port of Roelua to the
South, and its dependency, the
southern limit of which is Jang
Macatta, as Pagoda Davis,
in 90° 2' North latitude, including
the Islands of Jangiser, Pambae
and Monpae.

14. This agreement to commence
and have effect from the 1st
day of January 1847, of
the Year of Christ, and 15th
day of the month of Moosutuan,
1263 of the Hegira.
